Court of Appeals Moves to Temporary Offices

To make way for renovation of 160-year-old Court of Appeals Hall, the Court of Appeals will move to temporary offices at 286 Washington Avenue Extension in Albany over the Memorial Day weekend. The Court will open for business at the new location on May 28 and expects to remain at the temporary site through most of 2003.
