Bank On Manhattan is a partnership of retail banks, community groups, and government, led by the Office of Manhattan Borough President Scott M. Stringer. It is designed to help Manhattan's families open low-cost, safe checking accounts. The Bank On Manhattan checking account includes an opening deposit requirement of no greater than \$25, a monthly fee of \$0-\$6 (depending on which bank you choose), protection from overdraft fees, a one cent monthly minimum balance, and the ability to use foreign ID as primary ID.
