APPELLATE DIVISION, SECOND DEPARTMENT NAMES NEW CLERK OF THE COURT

NEW YORK— Hon. Hector D. LaSalle, Presiding Justice of the Appellate Division, Second Department today announced the appointment of Darrell M. Joseph as Clerk of the Court. His appointment is effective March 14, 2024. Since August 2023, Mr. Joseph has been serving as Acting Clerk of the Court.

“The Appellate Division, Second Department, as the busiest appellate court in the nation, is fortunate to have Mr. Joseph, a highly-qualified, hard-working, and dedicated attorney, serve as the Clerk of the Court. Mr. Joseph first joined the Appellate Division, Second Department in 2001, as a court attorney. From 2002 to 2010, he served as Principal Law Clerk to Hon. Howard Miller. In 2010, he

supervised the Court's Motions Department. In 2011, he attained the position of Associate Deputy Clerk, and was subsequently elevated to Deputy Clerk. Previously, Mr. Joseph worked as an Assistant Attorney General in the Office of the New York State Attorney General. He also worked at Windels, Marx, Davies & Ives and Kaye, Scholer, Fierman, Hays & Handler, as a Litigation Associate. He began his legal career as Law Clerk to Hon. J. Daniel Mahoney, United States Circuit Judge, United States Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit. In addition, Mr. Joseph served as an Adjunct Professor of Law at Pace University School of Law and Brooklyn Law School.

Mr. Joseph is a graduate of Massachusetts Institute of Technology and Pace University School of Law.
