ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

In the Matter of Gail Suissa, respondent,
v Chalom Suissa, appellant.

(Docket No. F-5591/96)

Appeal by Chalom Suissa from an order of the Family Court, Kings County, dated April 9, 2008. By decision and order on motion of this court dated May 15, 2008, the appellant was granted leave to renew a motion for leave to prosecute the appeal as a poor person on or before May 30, 2008, upon the submission of proper papers establishing that the appellant is entitled to poor person relief and is interested in pursuing the appeal. The appellant has failed to do so. Pursuant to § 670.4(a)(5) of the rules of this court (22 NYCRR 670.4[a][5]), it is

ORDERED that the Clerk of this court, or his designee, is directed to serve a copy of this order to show cause upon the parties or their attorneys by regular mail.
