Motion by the appellant pro se on an appeal from a judgment of the County Court, Dutchess County, rendered June 26, 2008, for leave to prosecute the appeal as a poor person, and for the assignment of counsel.

Upon the papers filed in support of the motion and no papers having been filed in opposition or in relation thereto, it is
