DECISION & ORDER ON MOTION

Appeal by Juan Ramos from a purported judgment of the Supreme Court, Queens County, rendered June 25, 2008. By order to show cause dated August 11, 2008, the appellant was directed to show cause before this court, why an order should or should not be made and entered dismissing the appeal from the purported judgment on the ground that no appeal lies from the purported judgment, as the purported judgment was nothing more than a proceeding to cause a judgment of the same court rendered June 30, 1997, to be brought to execution (*see People v Crawford*, 239 AD2d 514). Application by the appellant for leave to prosecute the appeal as a poor person.


Upon the papers filed in support of the motion and the papers filed in opposition thereto, and upon the application, it is

ORDERED that the motion to dismiss the appeal is granted and the appeal is dismissed; and it is further,

ORDERED that the application is denied as academic.
