Motion by the appellant to stay enforcement of an order of the Supreme Court, Nassau County, dated December 13, 2007, pending hearing and determination of an appeal therefrom, and to enlarge the time to perfect the appeal. ORDERED that the application is denied without prejudice to making a motion for that relief.
