Upon the papers filed in support of the motion and no papers having been filed in opposition or in relation thereto, it is

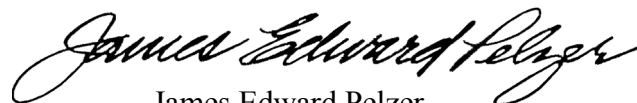
