DECISION & ORDER ON MOTION

(Ind. No. 111/05)

Motion by the appellant on an appeal from a judgment of the Supreme Court, Dutchess County, rendered September 7, 2006, to enlarge the judgment roll to include the transcripts of certain proceedings.

Upon the papers filed in support of the motion and no papers having been filed in opposition or in relation thereto, it is

ORDERED that the motion is granted; and it is further,

ORDERED that the decision and order on motion of this court dated January 24, 2007, which granted poor person relief to the appellant is amended to include a direction to the court reporter to make, certify and file two transcripts of the stenographic minutes of the following proceedings, if they are available:

- (1) December 13, 2005;
- (2) January 10, 2006;
- (3) March 7, 2006;
- (4) March 21, 2006;
- (5) July 18, 2006; and
- (6) August 21, 2006; and it is further,

ORDERED that the stenographer is directed to make, certify and file such minutes within 45 days of the date of this decision and order on motion, and the Clerk of the trial court shall furnish one certified transcript of each of the proceedings set forth above to the appellant's counsel, without charge (*see* CPL 460.70); assigned counsel is directed to turn over those transcripts to the respondent when counsel serves the appellant's brief on the respondent; and it is further,


ORDERED that in the event the stenographer has already prepared a copy of any of the minutes for a codefendant, then the Clerk of the trial court is directed to reproduce a copy thereof for assigned counsel; and it is further,

ORDERED that the appellant's time to perfect the appeal is enlarged; assigned counsel shall prosecute the appeal expeditiously in accordance with this court's rules (*see* 22 NYCRR 670.1, et seq.) and written directions; and it is further,

ORDERED that assigned counsel is directed to serve a copy of this order upon the Clerk of the court from which the appeal is taken.
