Autopsy on body of Grace M. Brown.

Frankfort, N. Y., July 14, 1906.

Height: five feet and one inch

2800

Female.

Body well nourished.

Complexion: fair.

Teeth: prominent.

Hair: dark.

Left central incisor overlaps right central incisor. 2801

Second toe of left foot is hammer toe.

There is present stasis of the body about shoulders and posterior portion.

Pupils moderately dilated.

Both eyes ecchymotic. 2802

There is rupture of vessels in both eyes, more prominent in left eye than in right.

There is a slight contusion over left malar bone; and there is a contusion of the top of nose and of the lips.

There is a puncture from the undertaker's needle over the left sternum and the right femoral artery. 2803

There is a mole over the pubes about the size of a lead pencil.

Both mammae contained milk.

There is a slight discoloration of both nipples.

There is a areola about the nipples and raising of the papillae. 2804

There was, present at the autopsy Doctors Hayes Richards, G. H. Smith, A. O. Douglass, E. H. Douglass and Coroner Coffin.

The thoracic cavity was found filled with embalming fluid.

The lungs filled the chest cavity.

2805 Condition of the heart:

Pericardium showed puncture from undertaker's needle through the right ventricle.

The right ventricle was filled with embalming fluid.

2806 Right auricle and left ventricle showed puncture from the undertaker's needle.

The pericardium contains blood.

There were small blood clots about the cordae tendinae of the left ventricle.

The right ventricle shows decided evidence of clots.

2807 From the right bronchus came a quantity of frothy mucus.

Crepitation was present in the right lung.

Upon being removed and placed in water, the right lung floats in the water.

2808 The left lung presents crepitation and also floats upon being placed in water.

Both lungs show decided evidence of red hepatization.

Posterior lateral portion of right parietal bone shows extravasation of blood in periosteum, that is, appearance is *antemortem*, external.

The scalp shows discoloration.

Center of extravasation is four inches above the helix of the ear. 2809

The discolored, or extravasized, area involves temporal, right parietal bone, portion of occipital bone on the right side.

The discolored area is about three and one-fourth inches in diameter, irregular in shape and slightly triangular. 2810

Skull was opened.

Dura Mater discolored and ecchymosed, corresponding with outside discoloration.

An incision was made through the dura.

The brain was exposed. 2811

Brain shows ecchymoses over full posterior portion.

There was no fracture of the bones of the skull present.

The left eye was then removed. 2812

The eye shows congestion, and the conjunctiva is injected presenting ante-mortem congestion.

Pupil was moderately dilated.

Brown in color.

Right eye is normal, except for slight congestion.

2813 Left eye was preserved in ten per cent. solution of formaldehyde.

An incision was then made over the left malar bone; showed ecchymoses of the deeper tissues; ecchymoses is shown down to the deeper fasciae.

Looking from above on the diaphragm, through the thorax, the diaphragm is elevated about three
2814 inches.

Vaginal examination shows perforated hymen.

The abdomen was then opened.

Uterus was removed.

Measurement of the uterus: from cervix to fundus,
2815 six and one-half inches; transverse, cornu to cornu, five inches.

Ovaries and tubes normal.

Antro posterior measurement three and one-half inches.

Upon palpation fluctuation was present.
2816

Bladder was normal and empty.

There was fecal matter in the rectum and sigmoid flexure.

The gravid uterus weighed two pounds, four ounces.

Uterus was then opened on the anterior surface.

Amniotic fluid was present in large quantities. 2817

The attachment of the placenta was central posterior.

Foetus was then removed; weighed six and one-half ounces; measured seven and one-quarter inches in length.

Foetus probably female. 2818

Age of foetus, about three and one-half to four months.

Stomach was removed and found to be normal.

It was ligated, removed and saved for pathologist. 2819

Kidneys were removed.

Both were encapsulated.

Weight of right kidney, four and one-half ounces.

Weight of left kidney, five ounces.

Both kidneys on section appeared normal. 2820

Spleen was removed and found to be normal.

Intestines were normal in appearance.

Liver was healthy and normal.

The stomach was put in a jar with ten per cent. formaldehyde.

2821 The left eye was placed in a jar containing ten per cent. formaldehyde.

The uterus and foetus were placed in a jar containing ten per cent. formaldehyde.

The jars were sealed by Mr. W. F. McGuire in the presence of Doctors Hayes, Richards, H. G. Smith, A. O. Douglas, E.H. Douglas and Coroner Coffin.

2822

From the findings of the autopsy the cause of death was primarily concussion, followed by syncope and then asphyxiation.

2823 The annexed and foregoing Case and Exceptions having been settled and signed by me, it is now and hereby ORDERED, that the same be filed in the office of the Clerk of the County of Herkimer, and by him annexed to the judgment roll in this action.
