CRIMINAL SALE OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE THIRD DEGREE (B Felony) (Sale of a Narcotic Preparation to a Person Less Than 21 Years Old) PENAL LAW 220.39(9) (Committed on or after Sept. 1, 1979)

The _____ count is Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree.

Under our law, a person is guilty of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree when that person knowingly and unlawfully sells a narcotic preparation to a person less than twenty-one years old.

Some of the terms used in this definition have their own special meaning in our law. I will now give you the meaning of the following terms: "narcotic preparation," "sell," "knowingly," and "unlawfully."

The term NARCOTIC PREPARATION includes (specify).¹

SELL means to sell, exchange, give or dispose of to another [or to offer or agree to do the same].²

A person KNOWINGLY sells <u>(specify)</u> when that person is aware that he or she is selling a substance which contains <u>(specify)</u>.³ For this charge, the People need not prove that the defendant was aware that the person to whom the <u>(specify)</u> was sold was less than twenty-one years old.⁴

A person UNLAWFULLY sells <u>(specify)</u> when that person has no legal right to sell it.⁵ Under our law, with certain exceptions not applicable here, a person has no legal right to sell <u>(specify)</u>.

In order for you to find the defendant guilty of this crime, the People are required to prove, from all the evidence in the case, beyond a reasonable doubt, each of the following three elements:

1. That on or about <u>(date)</u>, in the county of <u>(county)</u>, the defendant, <u>(defendant's name)</u>, sold <u>(specify)</u>;

- 2. That the defendant did so knowingly and unlawfully; and
- 3. That the person to whom the <u>(specify)</u> was sold was less than twenty-one years of age.

Therefore, if you find that the People have proven beyond a reasonable doubt each of those elements, you must find the defendant guilty of the crime of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree as charged in the ____ count.

On the other hand, if you find that the People have not proven beyond a reasonable doubt any one or more of those elements, you must find the defendant not guilty of the crime of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree as charged in the ____ count.
