Plaintiff's submissions rebutted defendants' prima facie showing of entitlement to summary judgment and raised triable issues of fact. On this record, triable questions of fact preclude summary judgment in favor of defendants.

Chief Judge DiFiore and Judge Garcia dissent for reasons stated in the dissenting opinion of Justice Anil C. Singh at the Appellate Division (see Barry v Lee, 180 AD3d 103, 108-114 [2019] [Singh, J., dissenting]).
