- 2. The motion is returnable on Mondays only.
- 3. Service: 8 days' notice is required for personal service

13 days' notice is required is required for service by mail.

The day of service is not counted.

For example: If you personally serve your papers on your adversary on May 1st, the earliest

date you can make your motion returnable is May 9th.

4. The Corporation Counsel <u>must</u> be served in all cases.
